

Center Skating Fees 2024 – 2025 skating season

Year team tuition fee (covers) \$1,750 per skater

-September to June Season of skating pays for 2 hours of ice per week & all coaching fees. On black out dates, it covers rental cost of local gymnasium to run practice off ice.

-ISI Yearly Membership (new members/those who wish us to renew)

-Team registration fees payable to ISI

-1st pair of competition tights (girls)

-Undergarments (girls)

-Partial costume cost (boys only – we match tight/undergarment fee)

Costume fee \$30 – 60 per skater

-cost is dependent on size/costume company

-teen synchro team keeps costume for 2 years (barring unforeseen circumstances)

-for programs like Team compulsories and production, we try to re-use costumes or use costumes/clothing skaters already own or can purchase to re-wear to keep cost low and within budget for families.

****By joining our team, you and your skater are committing to all the events in the regular season (September through late June). On the dates given the expectation of the team skaters and families is to expect that you will be at the event from start to finish. Please do not schedule additional events on these days. We have no control over the schedules put forth by the facilities and skating clubs. Events can run early or late; skaters may need to stay after competing for various reasons. Please keep in mind, the decision by 1 skater to not participate does not affect just that skater, but it affects the entire team and their outcome at the various events and practices.***

Practice Schedule:

On Ice: Saturday's 11am to 1pm Off Ice: Teen Team Saturday's 1:15-2:15pm

**Skaters should plan for these times every Saturday unless noted that there is no practice.*

**Teen Synchro team will have their first off ice practice on Saturday September 21st.*

*One 50-minute session will be designated for Synchro Skating Programs and the 2nd 50 min session will be used for Production, K-Skate and Team Compulsory Programs and any testing.

*During September Practices, the coaches will use more than 1 session to group all of the skaters together to learn the Kaleidoskate program from the 2024 District Champs for the October 20th Railers game. Utilizing an already choreographed program that most of the skaters know will make it easier to place and teach all new team skaters.

*Following the October 20th performance, the coaches will switch gears and start to prep all programs planned for the first competition of the season (Lake Placid & CSA).

*Skaters, a part of our teams that are also taking the Saturday Aspire group class prior to teams will have a break from 10:50 to 11:10 to give their feet a break (you **MUST** be back to the ice on time at 11:10). However, skaters who choose to skate on the freestyle session prior to teams starting are expected to be on the ice on time at 11am for teams.

*The number of programs planned for the season will depend on the number of skaters we have on our team.

-Example: The teen team will have a Short Program (new for 24/25 season), a Long Program (same program from 23/24 season) and a Synchro Dance Program (same program from 23/24 season).

- We are hoping to have enough skaters to break our youth team into 2 smaller teams

- The number of skaters will determine the number of additional programs we work through.
